Applications are accepted for full time study only beginning in the fall semester. To complete an application to the Virginia Consortium Ph.D. Program in Clinical Psychology (VCPCP) you must do the following:

- Online Application. Complete the online application through Old Dominion University (ODU). To begin this
 process, please go <u>https://app.applyyourself.com/AYApplicantLogin/fl_ApplicantConnectLogin.asp?id=odugrad</u>.
 Choose Psychology Clinical (PHD) as the Academic Interest. The application for the 2019-2020 admission year
 will only be available through December 1st at 11:59pm.
- 2. **Application Cover Sheet.** Submit the VCPCP cover sheet, which will provide basic information that will assist in the review of your application. You will be prompted to complete the Cover Sheet under the "Supplemental Materials (Psych)" section of the ODU online application.
- 3. **Supplemental Application.** Submit the VCPCP supplemental application. You will be prompted to complete the Supplemental Application under the "Supplemental Materials (Psych)" section of the ODU online application.
- 4. **Curriculum Vita.** Submit a current curriculum vita or resume in the "Supplemental Materials" section of the online application.
- 5. **GRE Scores.** GRE scores must be submitted; there is no waiver or substitute for this test. The Old Dominion University reporting code is **5126**. The GRE must have been taken in the past five years. Scores will be sent from ETS to Graduate Admissions approximately three weeks after you take the test, so **please plan accordingly so that your GRE scores will be submitted in advance of the December 1 application deadline.**
- 6. Letters of Recommendation. In the online application you will provide contact information for three (3) professional references and they will be contacted via email with instructions for how to submit a letter of recommendation. We encourage you to have at least two of the three letters from academic psychologists or professors who know you well. You must have three letters submitted by the application deadline in order for your application to be considered complete. Only three letters will be considered; if more are submitted, we will review the first three received.
