### **APPLICATION DEADLINES WILL NOT BE EXTENDED!**

Applications are accepted for full time study only beginning in the fall semester. To complete an application to the Virginia Consortium Ph.D. Program in Clinical Psychology (VCPCP) you must do the following:

- 1. Complete an **online application** through Old Dominion University. To begin this process, please go to <u>odu.edu/admission/graduate</u> and click on "Apply Now".
- 2. Submit VCPCP's **supplemental application**. You will be directed to the supplemental materials section of the online application at Old Dominion University.
- 3. Submit a current **curriculum vitae or resume** in the supplemental materials of the online application.
- 4. **Transcripts:** Please upload unofficial transcripts from each educational institution you attended as directed in the Educational History section of the Old Dominion University online application. You are required to submit all transcripts, even if courses taken at one institution are noted on the transcript sent by another institution. All offers of admission are contingent on receipt and verification of final and official transcripts. Official transcripts should be mailed to: **Office of Graduate Admissions, Old Dominion University, 1000 Rollins Hall, Norfolk, VA 23529.**
- 5. **GRE Scores:** GRE scores must be submitted; there is no waiver or substitute for this test. Applicants should use the Old Dominion University code of **5126**. The GRE must have been taken in the past five years. Scores will be sent from ETS to Graduate Admissions approximately three weeks after you take the test.
- 6. **Letters of Recommendation:** You must have three letters for a complete application. We encourage you to have at least two of the three letters from academic psychologists or professors who know you well. Only three letters will be considered; if more are submitted, we will review the first three received.

Please download the Virginia Consortium's <u>recommendation form</u>. This is the only recommendation form that should be used, easily identifiable with our program name in the upper left corner and our logo in the center. Complete the top section with your name and indicate whether or not you waive your rights to see the evaluation. Save the form and then send it to your recommender. Ask your recommender to save the form and then email it as an attachment to <u>gradadmit@odu.edu</u> with your full name in the subject line.
